Comix Mécanix - A Story of Comics and Watchmaking

From May 6, 2025 to February 6, 2026

The Espace Horloger of the Vallée de Joux is pleased to present *Comix Mécanix*, its new temporary exhibition, in partnership with the BDFIL comic book festival.

A unique project that brings together the art of comics and the mechanical genius of watchmaking, in an immersive and playful exhibition designed for all audiences.

Conceived by Angela Benza and Manon Roland, with scenography by Yves Morel, the exhibition explores the unexpected links between two worlds shaped by time, precision, and creativity. Illustrated watches, drawn stories, and original works all depict time through images.

Running from May 6, 2025 to February 6, 2026, *Comix Mécanix* is also part of the BDFIL festival, which features the partner exhibition *Clock Fiction, the Valley of Women Watchmakers*, showcasing twenty original comic boards focusing on the role of women in watchmaking. This second exhibition will be on display in Lausanne from May 5 to May 18, 2025.

On Saturday, May 24, 2025, the museum will open its doors free of charge, inviting the public to explore a journey that merges graphic and mechanical worlds. On this occasion, visitors will receive a personalized tote bag, can take part in a quiz, and enjoy a graphic challenge.

An exhibition at the crossroads of craftsmanship, storytelling arts, and watchmaking — to be enjoyed solo, with family, or with friends.
