EPFL Watchmakers – Quand le Temps prend Vie

From September 6 to December 14, 2025

The Espace Horloger of the Vallée de Joux is pleased to present its new temporary exhibition, "Quand le Temps prend Vie", in collaboration with the student association EPFL – Watchmakers.

Founded by watchmaking enthusiasts from various scientific and engineering disciplines at EPFL (École Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne), the association explores the encounter between precision mechanics, horological expertise, and innovation through concrete and collaborative projects.

The exhibition retraces the key stages in the creation of the association and reveals the result of their work: a unique modular clock, accompanied by interactive displays that allow the public to understand their approach, technical choices, and vision of the watchmaking of the future. From design to realization, "Quand le Temps prend Vie" highlights the transmission of watchmaking know-how while opening the door to technical innovations driven by a new generation of watchmaker-engineers.

From September 6 to December 14, 2025, visitors will be able to explore this fascinating universe through an immersive journey combining mechanical components, educational installations, and interactive experiences.
